

Blaine Thomas Weller Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is given in memory of Blaine Thomas Weller. It will be valued at \$500.

Qualifications:

1. The applicant must be a graduate of Palmer High School
2. The applicant must continue his/her education at an accredited college or university.
3. An individual must be registered as a full-time college student.
4. The scholarship is payable in two installments of \$250 per semester to the student's school. The student should maintain at least a "B" average the first semester of college.
5. Applicant must have a high school GPA of 93% or above.
6. The applicant must exhibit qualities of honesty, cooperation, respect for others, responsibility, serve on committees of student organizations, have high integrity, be dependable and demonstrate maturity of judgment.
7. Applicant must be active in several extracurricular activities all four years of high school.
8. Applicant must meet six of the seven qualifications.

How to Apply

1. Application must be submitted no later than the second Friday in April.
2. Fill out the enclosed application form in full, write a letter stating clearly your qualifications (include your plans, your high school activities, awards and other recognitions), and why you feel that you should receive this scholarship. Submit the application and letter to Mrs. Bruland by the second Friday in April. **NO LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE CONSIDERED.**
3. Ask three people to fill out the enclosed evaluation (recommendation) forms. Your choices could represent three separate interests (i.e. a minister, a teacher, a business person). No relatives. You should provide these people with a stamped envelope addressed to: Mrs. Denise Bruland, Chairman; Blaine Thomas Weller Memorial Scholarship; Palmer High School; PO Box 248; Palmer, NE 68864 or they can be handed to Mrs. Bruland personally.
