

Walter Kurz Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is given in memory of Walter Kurz. It will be valued at \$500 and will be provided until funds are depleted.

Qualifications

1. The applicant must be a graduate of Palmer High School.
2. The applicant must be an Agriculture Major at an accredited college, university, or trade school (2-yr or 4-yr)
3. The applicant must demonstrate academic stability.
4. The applicant must demonstrate leadership qualities and a high degree of school and community behavior.
5. The amount of the scholarship is \$500 It is payable in two installments of \$250 per semester to the student's school.
6. Selection is to be made by the Palmer Community Scholarship Committee.

HOW TO APPLY:

1. Application must be submitted no later than the second Friday in April.
2. Fill out the enclosed application form in full, write a letter stating clearly your qualifications (include your plans, your high school activities, awards and other recognitions), and why you feel that you should receive this scholarship. Submit the application and letter to Mrs. Bruland by the second Friday in April. **NO LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE CONSIDERED.**
3. Ask three people to fill out the enclosed evaluation forms. Your choices could represent three separate interests (i.e. a minister, a teacher, a business person). No relatives. You should provide these people with a stamped envelope addressed to: Mrs. Denise Bruland, Chairman; Walter Kurz Memorial Scholarship; Palmer High School; PO Box 248; Palmer, NE 68864 or evaluation forms can be handed personally to Mrs. Bruland.
4. Have your parent(s) or guardian write a short letter in which they make a brief statement of why this scholarship would provide worthwhile financial assistance to their situation. (This part is optional.)
