

Athletic Director's Meeting - May 17, 2021 - Via Zoom

- ❑ The meeting was called to order at 10:03. All schools were in attendance except Burwell, Humphrey St. Francis and Riverside. Central Valley arrived at 10:06.
- ❑ The minutes from the March 9, 2021 meeting were presented. Motion by Spalding Academy, seconded by St. Edward to accept the minutes. Approved 8-0.
- ❑ The Calendar for 2021-22 was presented for approval. Quick discussion took place on the Cross Country meet at Central City, St. Edward with back to back contests, Speech contest still in February and Spalding hosting Volleyball without a Volleyball team. Calendar approved 8-0.
- ❑ The Constitution for 2021-22 was presented for approval. The AD's recommended that Article 4, Section 3 (Athletic Director at the Executive Committee meetings) of the Constitution be removed and the Secretary-Treasurer act as the representative for the AD's. Discussion was on Article 4, Section 4 (\$200 to a separate person for keeping basketball/track stats). The AD's gave no guidance on the issue but needed it done somehow.
- ❑ A tie breaker system for the Sportsmanship Award was discussed. It was decided to recommend that the award either be done away with or if there was a tie that those schools all receive placards as co-champions, etc.
- ❑ The Basketball All-Star games with the Cornerstone Conference were announced with the Volleyball game May 28th at 6:30 @ Cross County High School and the Basketball games June 4th at 6:00 & 8:00 at Osceola High School.
- ❑ The AD's discussed whether to meet in person or via Zoom next school year. The decision was to do half of each with the more important dates in person.
- ❑ The AD's were reminded to talk to their Superintendents about adding a Junior High Volleyball/Basketball schedule to the conference.
- ❑ A motion to adjourn was made by Fullerton at 10:31 and seconded by Spalding Academy. Motion passed 8-0.
